NOVEC receives second

highest score among largest electric utilities in nationwide J.D. Power and Associates study

NOVEC SCORES HIGH IN CUSTOMER SATISFACTION

NOVEC customers who responded to the J.D. Power and Associates 2017 Electric Utility Residential Customer Satisfaction StudySM gave NOVEC the second highest overall score among the 138 largest electric cooperative, investor-owned, and publicly owned systems in the nation.

J.D. Power and Associates based its findings, released on July 12, on responses from nearly 100,000 online interviews it conducted from July 2016 through May 2017. Interview respondents represent more than 98 million American households.

The 2017 study gave NOVEC an overall score of 788 points — the highest score NOVEC has ever received in the study.

SECO Energy in Florida scored the highest with 789 points, followed by NOVEC, then Sawnee EMC in Georgia with 786 points. Seven of the 12 highest-scoring utilities in the nation are cooperatives. The average overall score among the 138 utilities was 719, based on a 1,000-point scale.

Among nine utilities in the Washington, D.C., area, NOVEC scored the highest. NOVEC has ranked on top since 2009 — the year J.D. Power and Associates adopted its present survey.

The study asked customers to respond to questions regarding their utility's power quality and reliability, price, billing and payment, corporate citizenship, communications, and customer service. NOVEC placed first in communications; second in power quality and reliability, price, and customer service; and third in corporate citizenship.

"We're pleased that NOVEC has scored at or near the top among the nation's electric cooperatives and utilities in the J.D. Power study since 2009. In that time, we have had the highest national ranking once and finished second twice." said Mike Curtis, NOVEC vice president of Public Relations.

NATIONAL 811 DAY ON AUG. 11 CALL BEFORE YOU DIG!

NOVEC recognizes National 811 Day on August 11 — the eleventh day of the eighth month. The Co-op reminds customers to contact Miss Utility at 811, 1-800-552-7001, or www.va811.com at least three days before you or your contractor starts a landscape or construction project. It's the law because the wrong shovel thrust can disrupt utility service for an entire neighborhood. More importantly, it can shock or electrocute someone, or cause a dangerous gas leak.

After calling 811, Miss Utility will notify the appropriate utility companies, including NOVEC. Locators will mark underground lines, pipes, and cables on your property so you will know their approximate location. If digging near NOVEC lines, please dig at least five feet from the marks.
