Save money this season by using these cold-weather energy tips:

- Open curtains or blinds on sun-facing windows to allow in sunlight and heat.
- Block cold air from outlets and switchplates with insulating pads and plug inserts.
- Turn off bathroom fans after bathing or showering to prevent heated air from being vented outside.
- Replace or clean your air filters to help your system operate more efficiently.
- Keep vents unobstructed by furniture, curtains or pet beds.
- Close fireplace flue damper and glass doors when not burning a fire to prevent warm air escaping up the chimney.
- Use a programmable thermostat to automatically adjust the temperature in your home to help you save energy.
